REACH

Dear customers,

REACH is a European Community Regulation on chemicals and their safe use (EC 1907/2006). It deals with the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemical substances. The law entered force on 1st of June 2007.

The aim of REACH is to improve the protection of human health and the environment through the better and earlier identification of the intrinsic properties of chemical substances.

The REACH Regulation gives greater responsibility to industry to manage the risks from chemicals and to provide safety information on the substances. Manufacturers and importers will be required to gather information on the properties of their chemical substances, which will allow their safe handling, and to register the information in a central database run by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) in Helsinki.

For the registration of substances in articles (e.g. manufactured goods such as cars, textiles, electronic chips), a special regime applies. The rules for substances in articles have been developed bearing in mind the need to adopt a proportionate approach to the millions of articles placed on the market in the EU, and the potential some of them may have to cause harm to human health and the environment due to the chemical substances contained in them. REACH requires all substances that are intended to be released from articles during normal and reasonably foreseeable conditions of use to be registered according to the normal rules, including tonnage deadlines and information requirements, if those substances are present in the articles above 1 tonne per year.


In addition, all substances of very high concern (SVHC, on a list of candidate substances for authorisation) present in articles above a concentration limit of 0.1% weight by weight and present above 1 tonne per year must be notified to the agency except where exposure to humans and environment can be excluded during normal conditions of use including disposal.

This is to certify that products supplied by NEXUS COMPONENTS are not subject to registration and do not contain SVHC. If this will change in the future, we will inform all our customers immediately.
